**Renewal of CEOS support to the Permanent Supersite “Mt. Etna”**

Dear Dr. Puglisi,

On behalf of the Committee on Earth Observing Satellites (CEOS) it is my privilege to inform you that the CEOS Plenary, at its 30th session on October 31 – November 2, 2016, in accordance with the approved renewal process, following a recommendation by the Data Coordination Team, has agreed to renew its support to the Mt. Etna Supersite.

CEOS agencies intend to support the Mt. Etna Supersite with the following data resources:

Centre National d'Etudes Spatiales (CNES)	Pleiades: 1 coverage per year (up to 40 in case of unrest)
Canadian Space Agency (CSA)	Radarsat-2: 30 scenes / year Archive data
Deutsches Zentrum für Luft- und Raumfahrt (DLR)	TerraSAR-X: 130 scenes / year, plus archive scenes of past acquisitions
European Space Agency (ESA)	ERS-1 / -2 / ENVISAT-ASAR, Sentinel-1, -2: Any available acquisition
National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA)	SAC-D/Aquarius: any available acquisition ASTER 44 images/year EO-1 (Hyperion) 22 images/year MODIS: any available acquisition
USGS	Landsat-8: any available acquisition
EUMETSAT	MSG-SEVIRI: any available acquisition
NOAA	NPP/Suomi: any available acquisition

Data will be made available free of charge for the purposes described in your proposal for the Mt. Etna Supersite, and on a best-effort basis. Individual data access procedures and applicable license and access conditions are identified in the instructions annexed to this letter.
