On behalf of the Committee on Earth Observing Satellites (CEOS) it is my priviledge to inform you that the CEOS Plenary, at its 30th session on October 31 – November 2, 2016, in accordance with the selection process accepted in November 2012, following a recommendation by the Data Coordination Team, based on the revised proposal you submitted in April, 2016, has accepted the Greek Supersite.
