



## **Session NH007: Geohazard Supersites and Natural Laboratories**

### **Session Description:**

The Geohazard Supersites and Natural Laboratories Initiative of the Group on Earth Observations (GEO) is establishing Supersites to support research on geohazards. Comprehensive data from satellite and ground-based sensors are made available to research groups to further understanding of geologic processes posing natural hazards. Focussing activities of research groups on regions of highest priority to the geohazards science community, allows creating comprehensive datasets by prioritizing limited resources of data providers.

This session provides a forum for discussing experience with the Supersites Initiative. Contributions may present research results in one of the Supersites or present progress and issues with establishing Supersites.
