Visa Support

To travel to Russia, most foreign nationals are required to have an Entry Visa. Applicants requiring a visa support should:

- 1. Submit <u>Visa support form</u> and scanned copy of a passport (the inside pages with photo and dates of validity, passport must be valid for at least 6 months after the date of departure from Russia) to the Local Organizing Committee (andreeva.planet@gmail.com) no later than 15 September 2017.
- 2. Receive the directive (telex) number from the Local Organizing Committee by e-mail.
- 3. Go to https://visa.kdmid.ru/ to compile and print the visa application (this telex number will be requested while compiling the application).
- 4. Apply for a Russian visa at the local Russian Embassy, Consulate or Visa center (with necessary documents and printed application form).

PLEASE NOTE THAT VISA APPLICATION PROCESS TAKES ABOUT THREE WEEKS, SO PLEASE STRICTLY FOLLOW THE DEADLINES!!!
